- The exercise was held from 25 to 31 Aug 15
- Shore phase was at Changi Command and Control Centre, Singapore
- Sea phase was off Pulau Bintan, Indonesia
- 13 ships, 5 AUV teams and over 800 personnel from 17 navies participated





Exercise Objectives

- To enhance inter-operability and mutual understanding among WPNS navies
- To exercise multinational staff in combined planning and real-time coordination of MCM Operations

Shore Phase comprised:

- Combined Exercise Planning
- Topical / Capability Presentations
- Ship Visits
- Establishing MCM Tasking Authority (MCMTA)
 - For real time coordination of MCM Task Force at sea
 - MCMTA initiated several sub-task studies to facilitate knowledge sharing and learning
