BACKGROUND

- The WPNS JOIP is an initiative agreed during the 14th WPNS meeting at Qingdao, China on 22 April 2014.
- Aimed to enhance cooperation and understandings of each navies' through the continuous engagements of Junior Naval Officers (JNOs) who would be future leaders of WPNS Navies.



OBJECTIVES

- Promote friendship and understandings of cultural differences amongst WPNS Navies JNOs
- Provide a platform for exchanges information, shared experiences of best practices and network amongst WPNS Navies JNOs
- To develop and enhance JNOs knowledge on shipboard duties of various WPNS Navies ships



GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- Activities are voluntary and non-binding
- Activities are organized to achieve the objectives at Paragraph 2 of this TOR
- The host navy shall determine the theme and scope of topics appropriate for the annual interaction activities.



Cont...



- Activities are flexible and to be decided by the host navy
- Each navy shall be represented by two participating officers of the rank of Lt (or equivalent)
- The duration of program should not exceed 5 days
- The host navy shall as a minimum bear the costs for meals during day activities, in-country transportation and programmed excursions

- Cultural Exchanges
- Senior Officer Talks



ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

- Arrival and departure arrangements
- Transportation arrangements
- Accommodation
- Attire requirements
- Security and Medical Services
- Details of program
- Diplomatic arrangements/clearance



REVIEW

- TOR shall be evaluated and reviewed after each program to ensure relevant to the objectives
- Host countries are to report the conduct and achievements of the program during the following WPNS meeting
