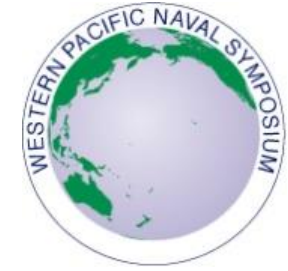


CUES : 3 years later

 - To propose some amendement to the document;

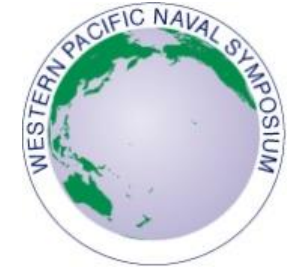

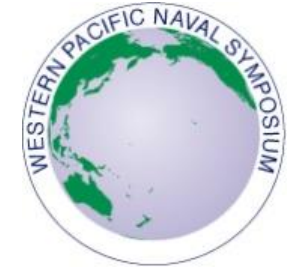

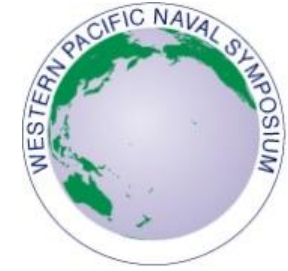
STRUCTURE

- **COMPOSITION**

- Only WPNS participating nations are eligible to join the CUES SC.
- The CUES SC composition principle relies on the voluntary basis for 2 years
- CUES SC composition has to be formally acknowledged in plenary session of the WPNS by the Chiefs of navy and heads of delegations. **Consensus**
- CUES SC members will designate a point of contact (POC)

- **LEADERSHIP**

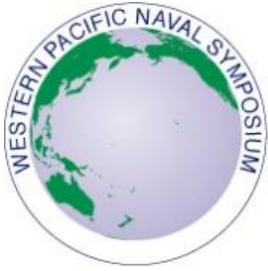
- On a voluntary basis, the Chair of the CUES SC should be designated in turn for a period of 4 years. The decision has to be formally acknowledged in plenary session of the WPNS by the Chiefs of navy or their representative.



CUES SC TASK



- Promote the CUES
- Establish and maintain the CUES national points of contact (POC);
- Maintain CUES lessons learned and database;
- The Chair of the CUES SC should be responsible for drafting a ‘work in progress’ summary, including a review of the latest CUES usage feedback and lessons learned and present this work in progress at the yearly WPNS
- Collect, record, examine and process any CUES amendment proposals according to the update process described in the hereafter paragraph 13.
- Maintain a reference site for all CUES related material on the All Partners Access Network (APAN);



13. Proposal process

a) There are five (5) CUES amendment proposal status :

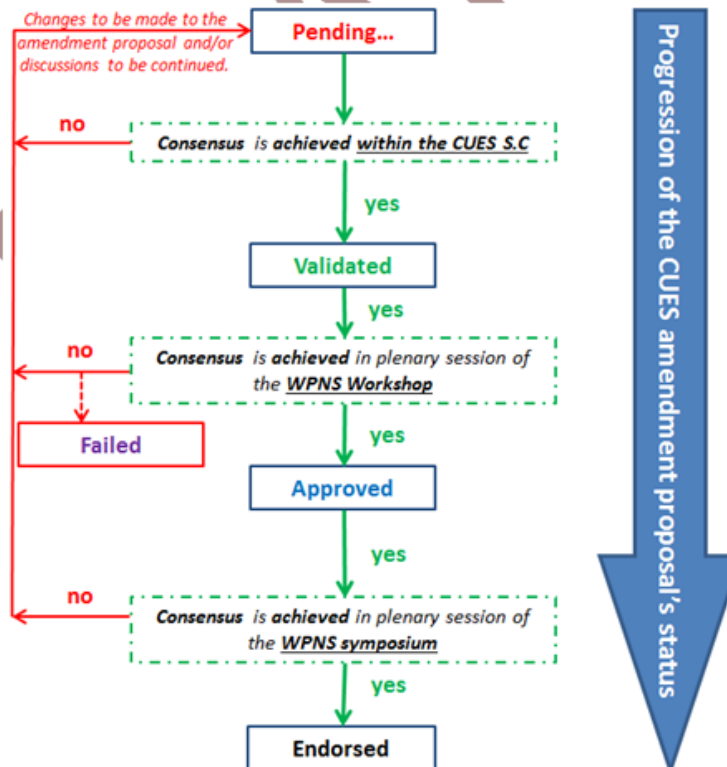
“Pending”: A proposal is pending once registered on APAN, and remains pending until validated, approved, endorsed or failed;

“Validated”: A proposal is validated once consensus is achieved within the CUES S.C ;

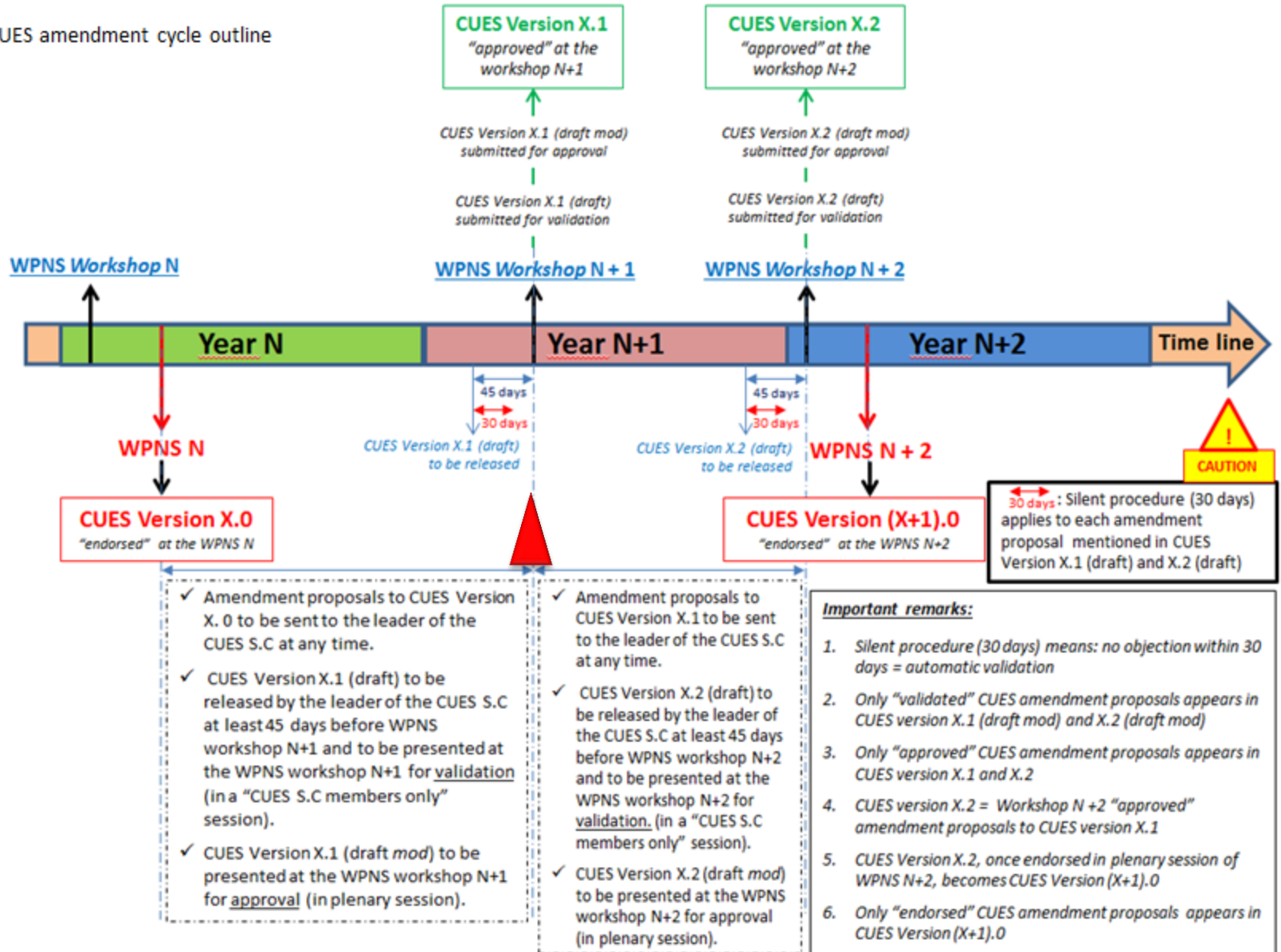
“Approved”: A proposal is approved once consensus is achieved in plenary session at the yearly WPNS Workshop;

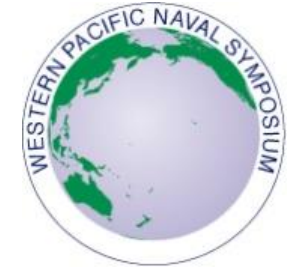
“Endorsed”: A proposal is endorsed once consensus is achieved in plenary session at the biennial WPNS;

“Failed”: A proposal fails if consensus is not achieved at the yearly WPNS workshop.

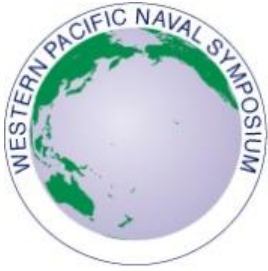

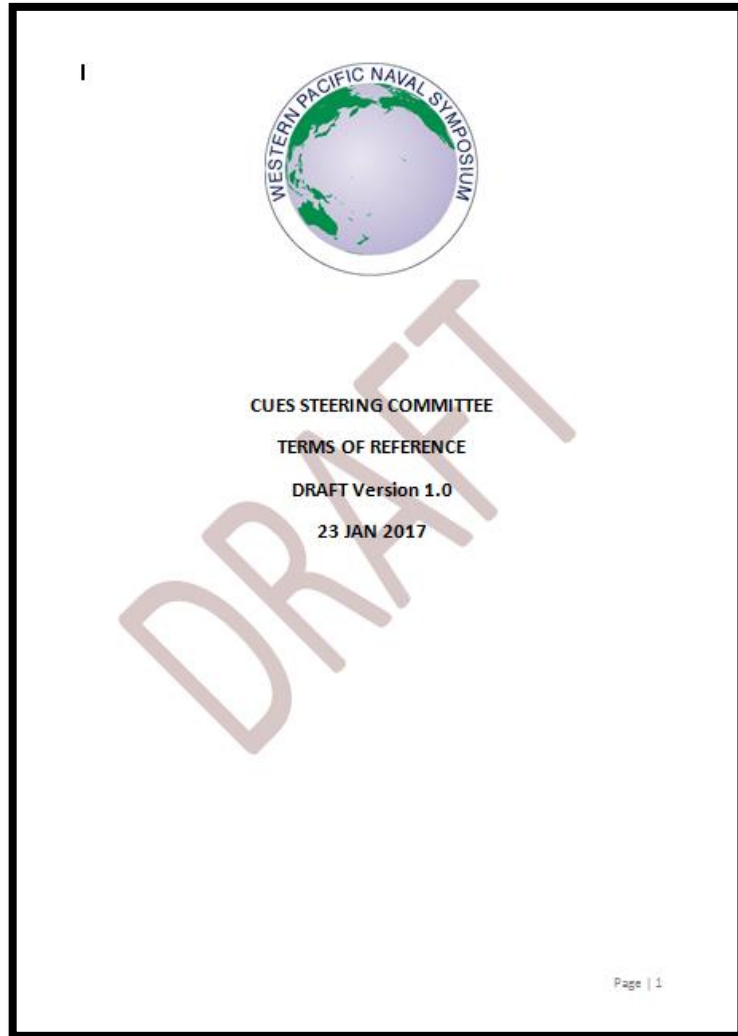
